36-48 Months

The children in this group are beginning to question as they understand the world around them. They are ready for short adult led tasks to develop listening and attention skills. The children will learn to play cooperatively with others and develop problem solving skills. You will see your child's independence grow as we encourage the children to help with small tasks such as at tidy up time, and as they put on their own shoes and coat.

The need for a key person becomes less prominent as your child starts to develop an understanding of their own needs/ feelings and who they are. They look to the key person for reassurance when they need it. The key person will carefully plan learning opportunities for the children to embed their understanding of the world in order to be ready for more structured learning in the next age group.

The children will have all their meals and snacks in Maple room.
